

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Transwaste recognised that it has a legal and moral responsibility to manage its activities in such a way to reduce the detrimental impact on the environment and are committed to taking practical steps to prevent or diminish harmful impacts on the environment.

Transwaste will continue to resource our management system to meet the standards of ISO 14001:2015. Where possible we shall use approved contractors and suppliers who hold environmental standards compatible with our own.

We are committed to continual improvement and implementing a framework which complies with the Environmental Agency, local authorities and other interested parties. We manage and mitigate our significant environmental aspects which shall be measured and audited.

We are committed to increasing the percentage of materials recovered and recycled from the incoming waste stream and reducing the amount of waste being landfilled. We are dedicated to assisting our customers in reducing their environmental impact by providing additional advice and waste management reports and plans.

This shall include:

- Periodically review environmental legislation to which the business activities are subject to ensure continued compliance with both the letter and spirit of the legislation.
- Establishing company procedures to ensure that waste is managed in line with legislation and that all parties involved in the waste production, transportation, and transfer and disposal process comply with their Duty of Care regarding waste control.
- Ensuring considered use of resources of all kinds, including the promotion of recycled and recyclable materials wherever possible.
- Compliance with all environmental legal requirements, regulations and guidance.
- Integration of environmental factors into business decisions.
- Planning work systems and practices to give due consideration to their potential environmental impact.

This policy is maintained as documented information, is available to our interested parties and communicated to all persons working under the control of Transwaste with the addition of each individual being made aware of their own obligations relating to the environment.
