

**Policy Statement:**

Transwaste have established an ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health and Safety Management System which provides a framework for measuring and improvement our performance.

Top management have established, implemented and continue to maintain an occupational health and safety policy that:

- a) we are committed to providing safe and healthy working condition for the prevention of work-related injury and ill health and is appropriate to the purpose, size and context of Transwaste and to the specific nature of our occupational health and safety risks and our occupational health and safety opportunities;
- b) provide a framework for setting environmental objectives;
  - 1) ensure work-related workplace injury rate is less than the waste industry average (currently 2,560 per 100,000 workers)
  - 2) delivery of 1 x Toolbox talk per month as part of a planned programme
  - 3) completion of 1 x contractor internal audit per month
  - 4) ensure 90% compliance of internal audits
- c) we are committed to fulfil legal requirements and other requirements
- d) we are committed to eliminating hazards and reducing occupational health and safety risks
- e) we are committed to continual improvement of the occupational health and safety management system
- f) we are committed to consultation and participation of workers, and, workers representatives.

The health and safety policy is available and maintained as documented information, relevant and appropriate.

The health and safety policy is communicated, understood and applied within Transwaste.

The health and safety is available to relevant interested parties, as appropriate.
